

DO YOU KNOW THE HARSH TRUTH OF COVID-19 DISPARITIES IN MINNESOTA?

"Essential employees" risk increased exposure to COVID-19. Many of them are **people of color**



Latinx Minnesotans are **testing positive** for COVID-19 at more than **9x** the rate of white Minnesotans



Indigenous Minnesotans are **hospitalized & placed in the ICU** at the highest rate of any racial group



Black Minnesotans have 4x the rates for COVID+ **deaths** than white Minnesotans



This data from the Minnesota Department of Health (<https://mn.gov/covid19/data/data-by-race-ethnicity/index.jsp>) continues to reveal deep racial inequalities related to COVID-19
