RACISM

IS REFLECTED IN WHO IS EXPERIENCING
HOMELESSNESS

BLACK (38%) AND INDIGENOUS (8%) PEOPLE ARE AT A
DISPROPORTIONATELY HIGHER RISK OF EXPERIENCING
HOMELESSNESS, DESPITE MAKING UP ONLY 5% AND 1% OF
THE STATEWIDE POPULATION.

OVERALL RISE OF HOMELESSNESS IN GREATER MINNESOTA

BETWEEN 2015 AND 2018

AN ESTIMATE OF 19,600 MINNESOTANS WERE WITHOUT
SHELTER ON ANY GIVEN NIGHT IN 2018. THROUGHOUT THE
ENTIRE YEAR, APPROXIMATELY 50, 600 WERE HOMELESS.
