

## **RN, On-Call**

The RN at St. Mary's Health Clinics supports the Nursing Supervisor, providing RN coverage in the absence of the supervisor or, when patient activity requires additional nursing hours or if assigned to special projects that are time limited. The RN is able to step in to assist with care coordination, new nurse orientation, direct patient care or special duties as assigned.

- Functions within the policies and procedures of SMHC and the Province of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet.
- Provide coordination of care for assigned patients on a temporary basis including making referrals, patient communication, documentation, and effective communication with primary care team.
- Support volunteer clinic staff as needed, including direct care.
- Participate and assist with new RN orientation, including clinic volunteers.
- Possess a solid knowledge related to public health and the unique needs of persons from diverse backgrounds, cultures, races and ethnic backgrounds.
- Knowledge of patient rights, responsibilities, HIPAA guidelines and applicable state and federal regulations.
- Support and honor the mission and ministries of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet, St. Paul Province.
- Professional behaviors, as outlined in the ANA Standards of Professional Practice.
- Maintain education required for licensure and certification if appropriate.
- Other responsibilities as assigned.

### Minimum Qualifications:

- Basic Registered Nurse education from accredited school of nursing
- Active Minnesota Registered Nursing license in good standing
- Minimum three year's work experience as an RN, preferably including acute care experience

**Schedule:** Daytime regular business hours. Average 16 hours / week unless covering for others could work up to 32 hours / week.
